ORDER MODIFYING PROBATION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on May 9, 2002, at the Board office, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Applicant, Thuong Van Nguyen, M.D., holding Oklahoma medical license no. 14885 appeared not.

The Board sitting *en banc* after hearing testimony, reviewing the request and other materials presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 2. Dr. Nguyen currently holds medical license no. 14885 under a three (3) year term of probation that commenced September 16, 1999.
- 3. On May 9, 2002, Dr. Nguyen and Board staff requested that the terms of Dr. Nguyen's probation be modified to allow him to accept and dispense sample medications from his office.
 - Board staff presented sufficient evidence to support the requested modification.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 et seq.
- 2. Board staff has presented satisfactory evidence to justify allowing Dr. Nguyen to accept and dispense sample medications from his office.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. Dr. Nguyen and Board staff's application to modify the terms of Dr. Nguyen's probation is **GRANTED**.
- 2. Dr. Nguyen's probation shall continue from the date of its commencement of September 16, 1999 under the terms and conditions set forth in the September 24, 1999 Order, with the exception that Dr. Nguyen be allowed to accept and dispense sample medications from his office.
- 3. Failure to meet any of the terms of this Order will be grounds for the Board to initiate proceedings to suspend or revoke Dr. Nguyen's medical license, after additional notice and hearing as required by law.
- 4. A copy of this written order should be sent to Dr. Nguyen as soon as it is processed.
