ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE

This matter comes before the Board on this 25th day of July, 1997, upon the Joint Application of the parties seeking an Order dismissing the above-styled action without prejudice to reassertion of any or all claims set forth in the Complaint. The State appears by and through its attorney, Danny K. Shadid. The defendant appears in person and by his attorney, Laura L. Cross.


The Board, having reviewed the parties' Joint Application, having reviewed the defendant's Application for Renewal of Oklahoma Medical License for the period of July 2, 1997, to July 1, 1998, together with all attachments thereto, having heard the argument of counsel and being fully advised in the premises, finds that the parties' Joint Application should be sustained and that the above-styled action should be dismissed without prejudice to the Board reasserting the claims set forth in the Complaint in opposition to any future application for a medical license, should such a license ever again be sought by the defendant. In this regard, the Board shall be allowed to assert any and all claims in

the present Complaint as a basis for the denial and/or probating of any future medical license sought upon application of the defendant.


