SUMMARY SUSPENSION ORDER

This matter comes before the Secretary of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision upon the plaintiff's Application for Summary Suspension. The plaintiff appears by and through its attorneys, Danny K. Shadid and Robert Trent Pipes. The defendant appears by and through his attorney, Mark Hammons.

The Secretary finds as follows:

1. This matter is properly before the Secretary pursuant to 59 O.S. Supp. 1994, §503.1 and 75 O.S. Supp. 1992, §314.
2. The Secretary has jurisdiction pertaining the plaintiff's Application for Summary Suspension.
3. The defendant admits that he is currently suffering from a mental disability such that he is not currently competent to practice medicine.
4. The defendant's medical license should be immediately, summarily suspended due to the defendant's present mental disability.

5. The defendant should be able to seek dissolution of this Summary Suspension Order upon a showing by the defendant that the aforementioned mental disability is resolved and that the defendant's competency has been restored.

6. This Summary Suspension Order and any future dissolution of this Order shall not prejudice either party on the merits on the underlying action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the medical license of the defendant, Terrence E. Murphy, be and is hereby summarily suspended pending further order of the Secretary of this Board.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the defendant be allowed to seek dissolution of this Summary Suspension Order upon a showing by the defendant that the aforementioned mental disability is resolved and that the defendant's competence to practice medicine has been restored.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that nothing in this Order shall prejudice either party in the presentation of claims, defense, and/or evidence on the merits of the underlying action.


