ORDER OF REVOCATION

This matter comes before the Board, en banc, on this 24th day of September, 1998, for rehearing on the issue of sanctions against the defendant's medical license, pursuant to the order set forth in the Memorandum Opinion of the Oklahoma Court of Civil Appeals, Division III, dated March 10, 1998, in the case styled State of Oklahoma, ex rel., Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision v. Terrence E. Murphy, M.D., Case No. 88,160. The State appears by and through its attorney, Danny K. Shadid. The defendant appears in person and by his attorney, Gene Stipe.

The Board, having before it the pertinent portions of the original trial transcript relating to the issues of over-prescribing, indiscriminately and/or excessively prescribing medications, having heard the argument of counsel and being fully advised in the premises, finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACTS AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board finds that there is clear and convincing evidence to substantiate the

following:

1. From December 1, 1993, through August 16, 1994, the defendant has engaged in unprofessional conduct by over prescribing medications, and/or engaging in the indiscriminate and/or excessive prescribing of medications in violation of 59 O.S. 1994, §509(17), together with Oklahoma Administrative Code §435:10-7-4(25).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision has jurisdiction in this matter by virtue of the provisions of the Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure and Supervision Act, 59 O.S. 1991, §481 et seq., as amended;

2. By virtue of the provisions of the Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure and Supervision Act, the Board has the power and jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of the Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure and Supervision Act to protect the public health, safety and welfare;


3. The defendant's conduct above constitutes a violation of the Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure and Supervision act, 59 O.S. Supp. 1994, §509(17), and Oklahoma Administrative Code §435:10-7-4(25).

4. The defendant perpetuates a significant harm to the public health, safety and welfare by continuing the acts and omissions set forth in the above allegations.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE THE ORDER OF THE BOARD that the license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Oklahoma of Terence E. Murphy, the defendant, License No. 14919, is hereby **REVOKED**.
