ORDER DENYING REINSTATEMENT OF <u>MEDICAL LICENSE</u>

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on May 20, 2004, at the Board office, 5104 North Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73118, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Terrence E. Murphy, Applicant, appeared in person and through counsel, Daniel Gamino.

Elizabeth A. Scott, Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.

The Board *en banc* heard testimony, reviewed the exhibits presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, entered the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1 Applicant previously held Oklahoma Medical License No. 14919.
- 2. On July 26, 1996, the Board revoked Applicant's license based upon numerous violations of 59 O.S. §509 and the Oklahoma Administrative Code.
 - 3 Applicant has applied for reinstatement of his license.
- 4. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

5. The evidence reflects that Applicant has not practiced medicine since 1995. The Applicant additionally obtained assessments at the Institute for Physician Evaluation and the Center for Personalized Education for Physicians, both of which found numerous inadequacies in his medical abilities.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein pursuant to 59 O.S. §480 et seq.

2. The Applicant has failed to sustain his burden of proof that he has met all requirements for reinstatement of his medical license, including, but not limited to the requirement that he has the ability to practice medicine and surgery with reasonable skill and safety.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. Applicant's request for reinstatement of his medical license shall be **DENIED**.
- 2 A copy of this written order shall be sent to Applicant as soon as it is processed.
