VACATION OF PROBATION

THIS MATTER comes on before the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision (the "Board") upon the defendant's Motion to Vacate Probation. Staff appears by and through counsel of record James Robert Johnson, Assistant Attorney General. The Defendant ("McCall") appears by and through counsel of record, Richard R. Bailey, Attorney at Law. And the Board, hearing the argument of the parties and otherwise being apprised of the facts and law in this matter, makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. This matter is predicated upon disciplinary action taken by the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners (the "Texas Board") against McCall on the 22nd day of February, 1991.
2. Pursuant to the action of the Texas Board, McCall was placed on probation for a period of ten (10) years under enumerated terms and conditions.
3. Thereafter, on the 9th day of September, 1994, this Board

placed McCall on probation for a period of five (5) years.

4. On the 26th day of October, 1994, the Texas Board reviewed this matter and terminated the probation of McCall, stating that McCall had complied with all terms and conditions of the Texas probation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


1. The Board has the authority to review disciplinary action taken by the Board at any time for any reason deemed sufficient by the Board. 59 O.S.1991, § 508.1.

2. The Board's disciplinary action taken herein was predicated upon action of the Texas Board. The subsequent action of the Texas Board to vacate that Board's probation constitutes sufficient reason to dismiss the administrative action herein and vacate the terms of probation imposed upon McCall.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board that the administrative action against Victor Eugene McCall, M.D., is hereby VACATED.
