COMPLAINT

COMES NOW the Plaintiff, the State of Oklahoma ex rel. the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision (the "Board"), by and through its attorney, Elizabeth A. Scott, Assistant Attorney General, and for its Complaint against the Defendant, Ross Lane Fisher, M.D., alleges and states as follows:

1. The Board is a duly authorized agency of the State of Oklahoma empowered to license and oversee the activities of physicians and surgeons in the State of Oklahoma pursuant to 59 Okla. Stat. §480 *et seq.*

2. Defendant, Ross Lane Fisher, M.D., holds Oklahoma license no. 15687.

3. On or about February 5, 2003, Defendant was involved in an automobile accident at which time he was arrested and charged with Driving While Under the Influence of Alcohol and Careless Driving. At that time, his alcohol level was .12%. Defendant subsequently plead guilty to the charge of Careless Driving and was ordered to attend twenty (20) AA meetings, obtain a state assessment, attend the state DUI school and pay a fine.

4. On or about November 16, 2005, Defendant was involved in an automobile accident at which time he was arrested and charged with Driving While Under the Influence of Alcohol. At that time, his alcohol level was .26%. When questioned by a police officer, he admitted he had been drinking wine. The charge against Defendant is still pending at this time.

5. From December 20, 2005 until February 10, 2006, Defendant obtained treatment at Rush Behavioral Health Center.

6. On or about April 6, 2006, Defendant met with Board investigator Dave Dicus at which time Mr. Dicus requested that Defendant provide his complete treatment records from Rush. Defendant stated that he would provide his discharge summary, but that he did not want the Board to have his complete treatment records from Rush and that he would not provide them.

7. Defendant is guilty of unprofessional conduct in that he:

A. Is habitually intemperate or habitually uses habit-forming drugs in violation 59 O.S. §509(4) and OAC 435:10-7-4(3).

B. Engaged in dishonorable or immoral conduct which is likely to deceive, defraud or harm the public in violation of 59 O.S. §509(8) and OAC 435:10-7-4(11).

C. Violated any provision of the medical practice act or the rules and regulations of the Board or of an action, stipulation, or agreement of the Board in violation of 59 O.S. §509(13) and OAC 435:10-7-4(39).

D. Is unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of age, illness, drunkenness, excessive use of drugs, narcotics, chemicals or any other type of material or as a result of any mental or physician condition in violation of 59 O.S. §509(15) and OAC 435:10-7-4(40).

E. Failed to furnish the Board, its investigators or representatives, information lawfully requested by the Board in violation of OAC 435:10-7-4(37).

F. Failed to cooperate with a lawful investigation conducted by the Board in violation of OAC 435:10-7-4(38).

Conclusion

WHEREFORE, the Plaintiff respectfully requests that the Board conduct a hearing, and, upon proof of the allegations contained herein, impose such disciplinary action as authorized by law, up to and including suspension or revocation and any other appropriate action with respect to Defendant's medical license, and an assessment of costs and attorney's fees incurred in this action as provided by law.
