FINAL ORDER
ON COMPLAINT OF CONTEMPT

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc on the 9th day of June, 1989, at the Doubletree Inn at Warren Place, 6100 South Yale, Tulsa, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff; and Jefferson Davis Erwin, M.D., Defendant, appeared in person and by counsel, Kenneth Brown, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

The Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc heard testimony and reviewed exhibits and being fully advised in the premises, the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision therefore finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Defendant, Jefferson Davis Erwin, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 15856.
2. That the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
3. That the Defendant did voluntarily attend six weeks in-patient treatment at Willow View Hospital in April and part of May, 1989, and is presently attending AA and NA meetings.
4. However, the Defendant is not yet ready to return to active medical practice and should continue with his license suspended until he fulfills requirements of the Physician Recovery Committee of the OSMA and until that Committee makes a recommendation to the Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That under the terms and conditions of the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. Supp. 1988, Sec. 481 et seq., and the Final Order of the Board issued herein following hearing on February 3, 1989, the Board has continuing jurisdiction over the Defendant and his Oklahoma Medical License.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That the license of Defendant, Jefferson Davis Erwin, M.D., Oklahoma Medical License No. 15856, should be and the same is to remain SUSPENDED from June 9, 1989, until the next meeting of the Board scheduled for October, 1989.

2. That the Board is holding in abeyance any sanction resulting from the allegations of the Complaint of Contempt of Board Order.

3. That a copy of this Order should be forwarded to Defendant by and through his counsel.
