

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That evidence indicates the Defendant in compliance with the terms and conditions of probation imposed on March 25, 1988.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That the Defendant, Stephen E. Torres, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 16429, should be maintained on the five (5) year probation effective March 25, 1988, but that Defendant should be and is hereby changed from Level I supervision to Level II supervision.

2. That within 30 days Defendant shall bring current his arrearage of \$515.88 on unpaid investigation, prosecution and probation costs, or personally meet with the Board Secretary and produce financial statements and tax documents concerning his financial circumstances and work out a repayment plan acceptable to the Secretary.
