FINAL ORDER
OF PROBATION ON MEDICAL LICENSE

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc on the 12th day of January, 1989, at the Holiday Inn, 3535 NW 39th Street Expressway, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff; and Norman Darryl Houchen, M.D., Defendant, appeared in person, pro se.

The Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc heard the testimony and reviewed exhibits, and being fully advised in the premises the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision therefore finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Defendant, Norman Darryl Houchen, M.D., holds Oklahoma Medical License No. 16779.
2. That the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
3. Defendant was lawfully served with a Complaint and Citation that alleged certain violations of the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. 1981, Sec. 509.
4. That in lieu of a formal evidentiary hearing, the Defendant did enter into and sign Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction and did submit to a five-year probation to the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision has lawful jurisdiction over this Defendant pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. Supp. 1987, Sec. 481 et seq., and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. That the Defendant, Norman Darryl Houchen, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 16779, will be and is hereby

placed on probation to the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision for a period of five (5) years beginning on the 8th day of October, 1988, unless earlier modified by the Board, under the following terms and conditions:

(a) That during the period of probation Defendant will not prescribe, administer or dispense any medications for his personal use, to specifically include controlled dangerous substances.

(b) That during the period of probation Defendant will take no medication except that which is authorized by a physician treating him for a legitimate medical need and Defendant shall have an affirmative duty to inform any physician treating him of Defendant's previous use of controlled dangerous substances.

(c) That during the period of probation Defendant will abstain from consuming alcohol or any substance, specifically including but not limited to controlled dangerous substances, which would adversely affect his ability to practice medicine or surgery as interpreted by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.

(d) That during the period of probation Defendant will submit biological fluid specimens to include, but not limited to, blood and urine, for analysis, upon request of any Investigator or other agent representing the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, and Defendant will pay for testing and analysis of those specimens.

(e) During the period of probation Defendant will continue active participation in support programs operated through the Physician Recovery Committee of the Oklahoma State Medical Association.

(f) During the period of probation Defendant will furnish to the office of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision all current legal addresses and any change of address in writing.

(g) Defendant shall appear before the Board or a designated member thereof whenever requested to do so.

(h) During the period of probation Defendant will submit to the Investigation Division of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision any required reports and forms on a timely and prompt basis.


(i) Pursuant to Section 26, H.B. 1478, 1987 Legislature, Defendant shall promptly pay upon receipt of invoice from the Investigative Division of the Board the costs of investigation, prosecution and probation of this case, except that costs imposed by the Board will be deferred and not payable until March 1, 1989, because of the Defendant's present financial condition.

(j) That violation of any of the terms and conditions of probation shall be grounds for additional charges to be presented to the Board after notice to the Defendant.


2. That the jurisdiction of the Board in this individual proceeding will continue in this matter until the terms and conditions of probation are modified or lifted by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on their own motion, or on the motion of the Defendant.

3. The Defendant further agrees that failure to meet any of the above terms of probation will constitute cause for the Board to initiate additional proceedings to suspend or revoke Defendant's Oklahoma Medical License, after additional due notice and hearing.
