EMERGENCY ORDER

NOW ON THIS 8th day of March, 1996, this cause comes on before GERALD C. ZUMWALT, M.D., Secretary, Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, upon the verified complaint of Steve Washbourne, Investigator for the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.

The Board was represented by C. Merle Gile and the defendant was represented by Terry T. Wiens. The defendant was not present.

The Secretary, having found an emergency existed upon consultation with the President of the Board, John Alexander, M.D., heard arguments from both counsel in this matter and found the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The allegations as stated in the complaint are the subject of testimony offered by Steve Washbourne, Investigator for the Board.

2. The defendant, through counsel, stipulated that the witness for the state, Steve Washbourne, would testify that the allegations in the complaint were true. The defendant does not admit nor deny these allegations but acknowledges that if questioned, the investigator would make these allegations.

3. The defendant entered treatment at St. Anthony Hospital and subsequently entered treatment at Rush Behavioral Health Center in Downers Grove, Illinois for substance

abuse.

4. The defendant voluntarily surrendered his medical license, number 16834 through his counsel.

5. The defendant will not be able to provide complete documentation from the treatment program on or before March 22, 1996 and, therefore, requests a hearing on this matter be scheduled for the next available meeting of the Board.

6. That suspension of the medical license held by the Defendant is imperative for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Secretary of the Board has authority to temporarily suspend a license on an emergency basis under the Oklahoma Medical Practice act, 59 O.S. Supp 1995 §503.1.

2. The Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision may conduct a full hearing en banc, pursuant to 75 O.S. Supp 1995, §314.1 "Implementation of emergency action pending final outcome of proceedings."


ORDER

THEREFORE the Secretary, orders that the Oklahoma Medical License of Jimmy Harold Conway, M.D., Number 16834 be and is hereby suspended until a meeting of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision can be convened in May to hear the case.

The Secretary therefore finds that the immediate suspension of Doctor Conway's license to practice medicine and surgery is imperative for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare and that his license should be temporarily suspended under the jurisdiction of this Board and 59 O.S. 1991 §503.1 and 75 O.S. 1991 §314.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that Doctor Jimmy Harold Conway's license, number 16834 be and the same is hereby temporarily suspended until the matter may be heard before the scheduled meeting of the Board in May of 1996.


