This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners en banc on September 30, 1983, at 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff and Maurice E. Lampton, Attorney, appeared for the Defendant.

The counsel for the parties then advised the Board of Medical Examiners of a proposed disposition of this case. Said proposal is hereby adopted and the Board of Medical Examiners issues the following Order:

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical examiners of Oklahoma as follows:


1. That the Defendant shall not provide medical services as a physician's assistant in any location or facility in the absence of his approved employing physician or approved backup physician.
2. Defendant's certificate to remain in full force and effect, without revocation and without suspension, provided that his future practices adhere strictly to Oklahoma law and the Rules of the Board of Medical Examiners.
3. That Defendant shall introduce himself to patients and patients' family members as a physician's assistant and that his identity as such is made clear.

COMPLAINT

COMES NOW D. C. Mosshart, Inspector for the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners, being first duly sworn upon oath and states:

1. That Bill Royce Evans, P.A., holding Oklahoma Physician's Assistant Certificate No. 170, is in violation of the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. 1981, §509


2. That Bill Royce Evans, P.A., is in violation of the Rules and Regulations promulgated by this Board, specifically Section X D, Rule 9, to-wit:

"Rule 9: A physician's assistant must function only under the supervision of a licensed physician. Independent health care by a physician's assistant shall not be permitted."

3. That on or around March and April, 1983, and on or around May 10, 1983, said Defendant was operating the Glenpool Medical Clinic located in Glenpool, Oklahoma, and was examining patients and performing medical diagnosis and rendering medical care without the supervision of a licensed physician. That said activities constitute independent health care by a physician's assistant.



That on or around May 16, 1983, said Defendant was operating the Glenpool Medical Clinic located in Glenpool, Oklahoma, and was examining patients and performing medical diagnosis and rendering medical care without the supervision of a licensed physician. That said activities constitute independent health care by a physician's assistant

WHEREFORE, Complainant prays this Board to conduct a hearing and upon proof of the allegations contained herein that such disciplinary action be taken by the Board as is authorized by law.
