The Board having considered testimony and evidence presented hereby **GRANTS** the motion to terminate the indefinite probation pursuant to the Corrected Order Granting the Lifting of the One Year Restricted License Under Terms of Indefinite Probation, filed April 26, 2013. A license is hereby issued pursuant to the Agreement for Licensure After Indefinite Probation, executed on March 7, 2019.

**This Order is subject to review and approval by the Oklahoma Attorney General, and this Order shall become final upon completion of the review by the Oklahoma Attorney General unless disapproved, in which case this Order shall be null and void.**

Dear Dr. Billy H. Stout, M.D., Board Secretary:

This office has received your request for a written Attorney General Opinion regarding action that the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision intends to take with respect to medical doctor licensee 17313 in case 98-12-2048. The licensee is currently working under terms of indefinite probation due to previous disciplinary action that occurred in 2013. The Board proposes terminating the indefinite probation and place the license on a non-disciplinary agreement.

The Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure and Supervision Act authorizes the Board to suspend or revoke a license and order other appropriate sanctions against a licensee for unprofessional conduct. 59 O.S.2011, §§ 503. The Board may believe that the proposed action is reasonable in light of licensee's circumstances and behavior.

It is, therefore, the official opinion of the Attorney General that the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision has adequate support for the conclusion that this action advances the State's policy of protecting the health safety and well-being of the citizens of Oklahoma.
