# ORDER IMPOSING TERMS OF PROBATION

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on September 1, 1990, at the office of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Board staff; and Gail Roger Williams, M.D., Applicant, appeared in person, pro se, waived his right to legal counsel, and desired to appear and proceed without counsel.

The Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc heard testimony, reviewed exhibits, and being fully advised in the premises, the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision finds as follows:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. That Gail Roger Williams, M.D., is an applicant for licensure in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon.
- 2. That the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 3. That the Applicant was previously licensed in the State of Michigan as a physician and surgeon, and that the Applicant subsequently stipulated to revocation of his license arising out of a sexual relationship with a female patient.
- 4. That the Applicant is presently remarried and is active in his church and has produced evidence to demonstrate that any past misjudgments will not be repeated in the future.
- 5. That the Applicant has contacted the Oklahoma Department of Corrections and the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and desires to practice in an institutional setting, and not in an unsupervised private practice.
- 6. That the Applicant may be licensed as a physician and surgeon in the State of Oklahoma under terms and conditions of probation that will protect public health, safety and welfare.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. That the Applicant did present evidence sufficient to document his qualifications for licensure in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon as set forth in the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. Supp. 1989, Sec. 481 et seq., and rules and regulations of the Board.

2. That the Board has jurisdiction and legal authority to impose probation on a license under circumstances to fit the evidence presented.

#### ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. That licensure in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon should be and is hereby GRANTED to Gail Roger Williams, M.D., and that said licensure should be under the following terms and conditions.
- 2. That the Applicant, Gail Roger Williams, M.D., should be and is hereby placed on probation to the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision for a period of five years, beginning September 1, 1990, under the following terms and conditions:
  - (a) That the Applicant will practice only in a supervised setting of a public agency and that Applicant shall not engage in unsupervised private practice.
  - (b) That any time the Applicant examines a female patient the Applicant shall have another female present to assist and witness the procedure.
  - (c) During the period of probation Applicant will furnish to the office of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision all current legal addresses and any change of address in writing.
  - (d) Applicant shall appear before the Board en banc or a designated member thereof whenever requested to do so.
  - (e) During the period of probation Applicant will submit to the Investigative Division of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision any required reports and forms on a timely and prompt basis.
  - (f Pursuant to Section 26, H.B. 1478, 1987 Legislature, Applicant shall promptly pay upon receipt of invoice from the Investigation Division of the Board the cost of investigation, prosecution and probation of this case.
  - (g) During the period of probation Applicant shall notify any hospital where he holds staff privileges, or clinic, or group, or State agency where he practices, of the terms and conditions of this Order and supply a copy thereof.
  - (h) That violation of any of the terms and conditions of probation shall be grounds for additional charges to be presented to the Board after due notice to the Applicant.
- 3. That the jurisdiction of the Board in this individual proceeding will continue in this matter until the terms and conditions of probation are modified or withdrawn by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, either on their own motion or on the motion of the Applicant.

4. The Applicant further agrees that failure to meet any of the above terms of probation will constitute cause for the staff of the Board to initiate additional proceedings to suspend or revoke Applicant's Oklahoma medical license, after additional due notice and hearing.
