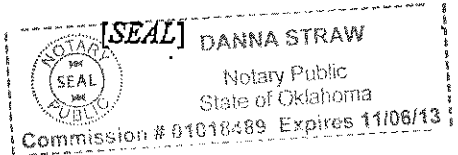


- C. As a result of the Court's finding that Defendant was insane, he was immediately committed to a facility designated by the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services to examine and treat forensic individuals.
- D. Defendant is guilty of unprofessional conduct in that he:
- I. Has been found mentally incompetent or insane by any court of competent jurisdiction in violation of OAC 435:10-7-4(16). Commitment to an institution for the insane shall be considered prima facie evidence of insanity of any physician or surgeon.
 - ii. Is physically or mentally unable to practice medicine and surgery with reasonable skill and safety in violation of OAC 435:10-7-4(17).
 - iii. Violated any provision of the medical practice act or the rules and regulations of the Board or of an action, stipulation, or agreement of the Board in violation of 59 O.S. §509(13) and OAC 435:10-7-4(39).
 - iv. Is unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients ... as a result of any mental or physical condition in violation of 59 O.S. §509(15) and OAC 435:10-7-4(40).
 - v. Engaged in practice or behavior that demonstrates an incapacity or incompetence to practice medicine and surgery in violation of OAC 435:10-7-4(18).
5. I will submit my wallet card and wall certificate as soon as possible as evidence of my intent to surrender my license.
6. I hereby agree that I will not apply for reinstatement of my Oklahoma medical license for a minimum of one year from the entry of the Order Accepting Voluntary Surrender in Lieu of Prosecution, and that if the Board ever reinstates my Oklahoma medical license, it will be under terms of probation to be set by the Board at the time of reinstatement.
7. As a condition to accepting my surrender of license in lieu of prosecution, I acknowledge that the Board may require me to pay all reasonable costs expended by the Board for any legal fees and costs, and any investigation, probation and monitoring fees, including but not limited to staff time, salary and travel expense, witness fees and attorney fees.
