# ORDER CLARIFYING MAY 12 ORDER ACCEPTING VOLUNTARY SUBMITTAL TO JURISDICTION

Before the State of Oklahoma, ex rel., Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision ("Board") for hearing on June 24, 2022, is Defendant's Motion to Clarify. Having reviewed the motion and hearing argument and presentation from counsel for Defendant, Shawn C. Schlinke, M.D. ("Dr. Schlinke"), and counsel for the Board, the Board finds that the motion to clarify should be, and hereby is, GRANTED.

The Board clarifies the May 12 Order Accepting Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction (the "May 12 Order") as follows:

1. The May 12 Order is not a requirement that Dr. Schlinke obtain a second opinion from another practitioner prior to diagnosing or treating a patient; but rather the cooperation between Dr. Schlinke and the Preceptor contemplated by the May 12 Order is intended for educational purposes only; 2. The May 12 Order does not prohibit Dr. Schlinke from writing a prescription for any lawful drug or class of drugs typically provided by other practitioners in the same or similar specialty as Dr. Schlinke; that is, Internal Medicine and Primary Care;

3. The May 12 Order does not contain a limitation on Dr. Schlinke providing examination, diagnosis or procedure without a second person present or approving the procedure;

4. The May 12 Order does not restrict, suspend or involuntarily terminate any hospital staff privileges of Dr. Schlinke;

5. The May 12 Order does not limit the maximum number of hours Dr. Schlinke is permitted to practice, nor is it a restriction on the type of Dr. Schlinke's employment;

6. The May 12 Order does not prohibit Dr. Schlinke from engaging in the solo practice of medicine;

7. The May 12 Order does not place a restriction on, or prohibition from, Dr. Schlinke performing a service or procedure typically provided by other practitioners in the same or similar specialty as Dr. Schlinke; that is, Internal Medicine and Primary Care; and

8. The May 12 Order does not contain any admission of wrongdoing by Dr. Schlinke.
