- 4. I am guilty of unprofessional conduct by violating the following rules of professional conduct:
 - a. Conviction of any felony in or without the State of Oklahoma and whether in a state or federal court. 59 O.S. § 513(a)(3); Okla. Admin. Code § 435:10-7-4(10).
- 5. I hereby submit my wallet card and wall certificate as evidence of my intent to surrender my license. 59 O.S. § 509(E)(2).
- 6. I understand that I cannot apply for reinstatement of my Oklahoma Medical license for a minimum of one (1) year from the date this surrender is accepted by the Board. If the Board ever reinstates my Oklahoma Medical license, I agree that it will be under terms of probation to be set by the Board at the time of reinstatement.
- 7. If the Board does not accept this Voluntary Surrender In Lieu of Prosecution the Plaintiff and Defendant (collectively, the "Parties") stipulate that it shall be regarded as null and void. Admissions by Defendant herein, if any, shall not be regarded as evidence against him in a subsequent disciplinary hearing. Defendant will be free to defend himself, and no inferences will be made from his willingness to have this Order accepted by the Board. The Parties stipulate that neither the presentation of the Order nor the Board's consideration of this Order shall be deemed to have unfairly or illegally prejudiced the Board or its individual members and, therefore, shall not be grounds for precluding the Board nor any individual Board member from further participation in proceedings related to the matters set forth herein.
- 8. As a condition to accepting my voluntary surrender of license in lieu of prosecution, I acknowledge that the Board shall require me to pay all costs expended by the Board for any legal fees and cost, any investigation, probation and monitoring fees, including but not limited to staff time, salary and travel expense, witness fees and attorney fees.
