COMPLAINT

COMES NOW the plaintiff, the State of Oklahoma ex rel. the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision (the "Board"), by and through its attorney, Elizabeth A. Scott, Assistant Attorney General, and for its Complaint against the Defendant, Kenneth Glen Petty, M.D., Oklahoma medical license no. 18506, alleges and states as follows:

- 1. The Board is a duly authorized agency of the State of Oklahoma empowered to license and oversee the activities of physicians and surgeons in the State of Oklahoma pursuant to 59 Okla. Stat. §480 *et seq*.
- 2. Defendant, Kenneth Glen Petty, M.D., holds Oklahoma medical license no. 18506.

- 3. On or about September 25, 2001, in the District Court of Sevier County, State of Utah, Defendant plead guilty to POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, PSYLOCYBIN MUSHROOMS, a Third Degree Felony, POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, MARIJUANA, a Class B Misdemeanor, CARRYING A CONCEALED WEAPON, a Class B Misdemeanor, and FAILURE TO STOP AT A STOP SIGN, a Class C. Misdemeanor.
- 4. On or about April 15, 2003, the Missouri State Board of Registration for the Healing Arts **REVOKED** Defendant's Missouri medical license based upon Defendant's plea of guilty to the charges set forth above.
 - 5. Defendant is guilty of unprofessional conduct in that he:
 - A. Habitually uses habit-forming drugs in violation 59 O.S. 407 §509(5) and OAC 435:10-7-4(3).
 - B. Engaged in dishonorable or immoral conduct which is likely to deceive, defraud or harm the public in violation of 59 O.S. §509(9) and OAC 435:10-7-4(11).
 - C. Violated any provision of the medical practice act or the rules and regulations of the Board or of an action, stipulation, or agreement of the Board in violation of 59 O.S. §509(14) and OAC 435:10-7-4(39).
 - D. Is unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of age, illness, drunkenness, excessive use of drugs, narcotics, chemicals or any other type of material or as a result of any mental or physician condition in violation of 59 O.S. §509(16) and OAC 435:10-7-4(40).
 - E. Purchased or prescribed a regulated substance in Schedules I through V for the physician's personal use in violation of OAC 435:10-7-4(5).
 - F. Prescribed, sold, administered, distributed, ordered or gave a drug legally classified as a controlled substance or recognized as an addictive dangerous drug to a family member or to himself or herself in violation of OAC 435:10-7-4(26).
 - G. Prescribed, sold, administered, distributed, ordered or gave any drug legally classified as a controlled substance or recognized as an addictive or dangerous drug for other than medically accepted therapeutic purposes in violation of OAC 435:10-7-4(24).

- H. Confessed to a crime involving a violation of the antinarcotic laws of the federal government or the laws of this state in violation of 59 O.S. §509(8).
- I. Violated a state or federal law or regulation relating to controlled substances in violation of OAC 435:10-7-4(27).

Conclusion

WHEREFORE, plaintiff requests that the Board conduct a hearing, and upon proof of the allegations contained herein, impose such disciplinary action as authorized by law, up to and including the revocation or suspension of the Defendant's license to practice as a physician and surgeon in the State of Oklahoma, the assessment of costs and fees incurred in this action, and any other appropriate action with respect to Defendant's license to practice as a physician and surgeon in the State of Oklahoma.
