ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on May 16, 2013, at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as require by law and rules of the Board.

Defendant, Paul Powen Cheng, M.D., appeared in person pro se.

Scott Randall Sullivan, Special Prosecutor for the Board, appeared on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.

The Board *en banc* heard testimony, reviewed the exhibits presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, the Board entered the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

Findings of Fact

- 1. Defendant has submitted a motion requesting his probation be terminated, related to his Oklahoma medical license no. 18914.
- 2. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 3. On November 14, 2008, this matter came before the Board *en banc* resulting in an Order Granting Reinstatement of License Under Terms of Probation. The probation was ordered for a period of five (5) years.

4. Defendant is now requesting that his probation be terminated prior to the expiration of the five-year term.

Conclusions of Law

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction to reinstate the license of a physician pursuant to 59 O.S. §508.1.
- 2. The Board may impose practice parameters and other restrictions as necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public under 509 O.S. §480 et seq.

<u>Order</u>

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. The Order of Probation is terminated and Defendant's medical license shall be reinstated with no restrictions.
 - 2. A copy of this written order shall be sent to Defendant as soon as it is processed.
 - 3. This Order shall be effective May 16, 2013.
