## **ORDER MODIFYING PROBATION**

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on September 28, 2000, at the Board office, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Applicant, John C. Fucci, M.D., holding Oklahoma medical license no. 19139, appeared in person without counsel, thereby waiving his right to legal representation.

The Board sitting *en banc* after hearing testimony, reviewing the request and other materials presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

### FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

2. Dr. Fucci currently holds medical license no. 19139 under a five-year term of probation that commenced February 5, 1998.

3. On August 28, 2000, Dr. Fucci requested that the terms of his probation be modified to allow him to prescribe Schedule II and III controlled dangerous drugs.

4. Dr. Fucci presented sufficient evidence to support the requested modification.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 et seq.

Dr. Fucci has presented satisfactory evidence to justify allowing him to prescribe 2. Schedule II and III controlled dangerous drugs.

#### ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

Dr. Fucci's application to modify the terms of his probation is GRANTED. 1.

2. Dr. Fucci's probation shall continue for five (5) years from the date of its commencement of February 5, 1998 under the terms and conditions set forth in the February 5, 1998 Order, with the exception that Dr. Fucci be allowed to prescribe Schedule II and III controlled dangerous drugs.

3. Failure to meet any of the terms of this Order will be grounds for the Board to initiate proceedings to suspend or revoke Dr. Fucci's medical license, after additional notice and hearing as required by law.

A copy of this written order should be sent to Dr. Fucci as soon as it is processed. 4.
