SECOND ORDER TABLING APPLICATION FOR REINSTATMENT OF MEDICAL LICENSE

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on September 21, 2006, at the office of the Board, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board. Applicant appeared in person and pro se.

The Board *en banc* heard testimony, reviewed the application and all attached exhibits, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Applicant applied for reinstatement of his license in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon.
- 2. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 3. On or about March 25, 2004, Applicant's license was **SUSPENDED** until he (a) completed a psychiatric evaluation with a Board certified psychiatrist not previously disciplined by the Board and approved in advance by the Board Secretary, and (b) his criminal case styled **State of Oklahoma v. Lee Edward Brown,** Case No. CF-2003-700 in the District Court of Cleveland County, State of Oklahoma was completed, at which time he could present the results of the evaluation to the Board for its consideration.
- 4. The evidence reflects that on September 21, 2006, the Board considered Applicant's application for reinstatement. Applicant submitted the results of his criminal case to the Board. However, the evaluation Applicant submitted from Gerald M. Abraham, M.D., did not contain

sufficient information regarding a psychiatric evaluation for the Board to consider it. The Board requested that the application be tabled until it receives detailed evaluations from both Dr. Abraham and A. Louis O'Connor, PhD, a psychologist who had previously evaluated the Applicant. The Board requested that the Board Secretary communicate directly with Dr. Abraham and Dr. O'Connor to advise them of the information required by the Board for a complete evaluation.

5. Applicant's request for reinstatement of his medical license should be tabled without further consideration until the Board receives detailed and complete evaluations from Dr. Abraham and Dr. O'Connor containing the information required by the Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has legal authority to table an application when evidence on the application is insufficient to allow evaluation by the Board to make a final judgment as to whether the Applicant fulfills the requirements of 59 Okla. Stat. §481 *et seq.*, and the applicable rules of the Board to qualify for licensure in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon.

ORDER

It is therefore **ORDERED** by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. The reinstatement application of LEE EDWARD BROWN for licensure in Oklahoma as a physician and surgeon should be **TABLED**.
- 2. The Board will make no further consideration on this reinstatement application until the Board receives detailed and complete evaluations from Dr. Abraham and Dr. O'Connor containing the information required by the Board.
- 3. A copy of this written order should be sent to the Applicant as soon as it is processed.
