**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S
REQUEST TO TERMINATE SUSPENSION OF LICENSE**

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision ("Board") on May 4, 2017, at the office of the Board, 101 N.E. 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

A Final Order of Suspension was filed on April 1, 2004. Defendant's suspension to remain in effect until certain requirements were completed, at which time he may present the results to the Board for its consideration.

On August 12, 2005, Defendant submitted a letter motion to terminate suspension of license and on August 30, 2005, Defendant submitted a letter Petition for Rehearing.

On February 3, 2006 and October 6, 2006, Orders Tabling Defendant's Application for Reinstatement were filed.


The Board received correspondence from Defendant dated March 20, 2017, March 21, 2017, and April 10, 2017, to appear before the Board on May 4, 2017 to consider the following: (1) remove the suspension from Defendant's license, (2) reinstatement of a full unrestricted Oklahoma medical license with no disciplinary action, and (3) change Defendant's historical information on the Board's website.

At the May 4, 2017 Board meeting, Joseph L. Ashbaker, Assistant Attorney General appeared on behalf of the Plaintiff. Defendant appeared in person *pro se*, and testified on his own behalf. Mr. Ashbaker advised and that Defendant has met all of the Board's requirements for termination of the suspension. Mr. Ashbaker further stated that Defendant may apply for reinstatement of his Oklahoma medical license through the Board's licensing department.

The Board having considered statements of counsel, testimony and evidence presented concluded that Defendant's request for removal of the suspension from Defendant's license should be **GRANTED**. The website will reflect that Dr. Brown's suspension has been terminated. No other information will be changed. No action was taken on Defendant's request for reinstatement prior to the filing of an application..

This Order is subject to review and approval by the Oklahoma Attorney General and this Order shall become final upon completion of the review by the Oklahoma Attorney General unless disapproved, in which case this Order shall be null and void.
