**ORDER MODIFYING LICENSE RESTRICTIONS**

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Medical Board of Licensure and Supervision on January 16, 2014 at the office of the Board, 101 N.E. 51<sup>st</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Defendant, Jeffrey H. Schimandle, M.D., appeared in person and with his attorney, Daniel Gamino.

Matthew Stangl, Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.

The Board *en banc* heard testimony, reviewed the application and being fully apprised of the premises, entered the following Findings of Fact, conclusions of Law, and Orders:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and rules of the Board.
2. On November 8, 2012 the Board issued an Order Granting Reinstatement of License With Restrictions After Prior Revocation.
3. On January 16, 2014, Dr. Schimandle requested that the restriction on his license requiring satisfactory completion of a one-year ACGME approved Spine Surgery Fellowship in order to be allowed surgical privileges be modified. Due to the fact that

ACGME does not accredit fellowships, Dr. Schimandle asked that he be allowed surgical privileges upon satisfactory completion of a one-year orthopedic fellowship.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The Board has jurisdiction to reinstate the license of a physician pursuant to 59 O.S. §508.1.
2. The Board may impose practice parameters and other restrictions as necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public under 59 O.S. §480 *et seq.*

**ORDER**


It is therefore **ORDERED** by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:


1. Dr. Schimandle's Motion to Modify Board Order is GRANTED and paragraph 1 C of the Order Granting Reinstatement of License With Restrictions After Prior Revocation is modified to state:


"Dr. Schimandle shall only be allowed surgical privileges upon satisfactory completion of a one-year orthopedic fellowship."

2. This condition shall remain in effect until Dr. Schimandle appears before the Board to show proof of satisfactory completion of a one-year orthopedic fellowship.
3. A copy of this written order should be sent to Dr. Schimandle as soon as it is processed.


