SECOND ORDER DENYING TERMINATION OF PROBATION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on July 21, 2005, at the Board's office, 5104 North Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73118, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Lonnie William Litchfield appeared in person and pro se.

Elizabeth A. Scott, Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.

The Board *en banc* heard testimony, reviewed the exhibits presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

Findings of Fact

- 1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 2. Dr. Litchfield currently holds medical license no. 19449 under a five (5) year term of probation that commenced on January 17, 2004.
- 3. On March 10, 2005, Dr. Litchfield requested that his probation be terminated so as to allow him to work at the VA Medical Center in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The Board denied Dr. Litchfield's request.
- 4. On July 21, 2005, Dr. Litchfield requested that his probation be terminated so as to allow him to obtain credentialing at Oklahoma hospitals where he had applied for a position.

5. Dr. Litchfield failed to present sufficient evidence to support the requested early termination.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear requests for termination of probation on licenses under 59 Okla. Stat. §480 et seq.
- 2. The Board may impose practice parameters and other restrictions as necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public under 59 Okla. Stat. §480 et seq.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1 Dr. Litchfield's request for termination of probation is **DENIED**.
- 2. A copy of this written order shall be sent to Dr. Litchfield as soon as it is processed.
