VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE IN LIEU OF PROSECUTION

I, Daniel Clayton Clinkenbeard, M.D. ("Defendant"), being of lawful age and after first being duly sworn, depose and state as follows:


1. I hereby voluntarily surrender my Oklahoma medical license no. 20222, effective May 7, 2020.
2. The surrender of my license is freely and voluntarily made. I have not been subject to any coercion or duress, and I am fully aware of the consequences of the surrender of my license.
3. I admit that I violated the standard of care with respect to appropriate boundaries between doctor and patient in my official capacity as a physician in the State of Oklahoma.
4. I, Daniel Clayton Clinkenbeard, M.D., agree I am guilty of unprofessional conduct by violating the following rules of professional conduct:
 - a. Dishonorable or immoral conduct which is likely to harm the public in violation of 59 O.S. § 509(8).

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- b. Abuse of a physician's position of trust in the doctor-patient relationship in violation of OAC 435:10-7-4(44).
5. I hereby submit my wallet card and wall certificate as evidence of my intent to surrender my license. 59 O.S. § 509(E)(2).
6. I hereby agree that I will not reapply for reinstatement of my Oklahoma medical license for a minimum of one (1) year from the date this Voluntary Surrender in Lieu of Prosecution ("SILOP") is accepted by the Board. After the one (1) year period has expired, Defendant can apply for reinstatement upon conclusion of a treatment program pre-approved by the Board/Board Secretary which must be completed with all recommendations in place prior to seeking the proposed reinstatement
7. If the Board ever reinstates my license, I agree it shall be under the following terms:
- a. Defendant shall be placed on PROBATION after reinstatement and shall abide by all terms and conditions thereof;
- b. Defendant agrees to abide by terms, conditions and recommendations from the treatment center if reinstated.
8. If the Board does not accept this Voluntary Surrender In Lieu of Prosecution the Plaintiff and Defendant (collectively, the "Parties") stipulate that it shall be regarded as null and void. Admissions by Defendant herein, if any, shall not be regarded as evidence against him in a subsequent disciplinary hearing. Defendant will be free to defend himself, and no inferences will be made from his willingness to have this Order accepted by the Board. The Parties stipulate that neither the presentation of the Order nor the Board's consideration of this Order shall be deemed to have unfairly or illegally prejudiced the Board or its individual members and, therefore, shall not be grounds for precluding the Board nor any individual Board member from further participation in proceedings related to the matters set forth herein.
9. As a condition to accepting my voluntary surrender of license in lieu of prosecution, I acknowledge that the Board shall require me to pay all costs expended by the Board for any legal fees and cost, any investigation, probation and monitoring fees, including but not limited to staff time, salary and travel expense, witness fees and attorney fees. The costs must be paid within one year of the date of this Order.
