

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 *et seq.*

2. Dr. Lofgren has presented satisfactory evidence to justify termination of the remainder of her probationary period. The purposes of the probationary period have been accomplished. No useful purpose would be gained by having Dr. Lofgren serve the remainder of her probationary term.


ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. Dr. Lofgren's application to terminate probation is **GRANTED** and her probationary period is terminated effective January 26, 2006.
