ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on January 26, 2006, at the Board office, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Applicant, Darla Brummell Lofgren, M.D., holding Oklahoma medical license no. 20287, appeared in person and pro se.

The Board sitting *en banc* after hearing testimony, reviewing the request and other materials presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
- 2. Dr. Lofgren currently holds medical license no. 20287 under a six (6) year term of probation that commenced on or around May 22, 2000.
- 3. Dr. Lofgren has requested that her probation be terminated effective January 26, 2006 so as to allow her to timely register to take her board examinations.
- 4. Tom Sosbee, Compliance and Education Coordinator for the Board, testified that the Board staff has no objection to the requested early termination.
- 5. Dr. Lofgren has presented sufficient evidence to support the requested early termination.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 et seq.

2. Dr. Lofgren has presented satisfactory evidence to justify termination of the remainder of her probationary period. The purposes of the probationary period have been accomplished. No useful purpose would be gained by having Dr. Lofgren serve the remainder of her probationary term.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. Dr. Lofgren's application to terminate probation is **GRANTED** and her probationary period is terminated effective January 26, 2006.
- 2. A copy of this written order should be sent to Dr. Lofgren as soon as it is processed.
