**8<sup>th</sup> ORDER OF CONTINUANCE**

The undersigned Secretary for the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, in consideration of the Defendant's eighth request for a continuance, enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. Defendant's hearing on the Complaint and Citation pending in this case was initially set for May 19, 2011, then was continued until the July 14, and September 15, 2011 Board meetings, and then to the January 12, March 8, July 12 and November 8, 2012 Board meetings.

of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc at its next regularly scheduled meeting January 10, 2013.


