
DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE

COMES NOW the plaintiff, the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, and for its Dismissal Without Prejudice, submits the following:

1. On or about August 16, 2007, the State filed a Complaint and Citation against Defendant based upon allegations of unprofessional conduct, specifically, disciplinary action in Illinois whereby his license was suspended.


