VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE IN LIEU OF PROSECUTION

I, Bryan Frank Perry, M.D. ("Defendant"), being of lawful age and after first being duly sworn, depose and state as follows:

- 1. I am Bryan Frank Perry, M.D., holding Oklahoma Medical License No. 20773.
- 2. I hereby voluntarily surrender my Oklahoma medical license No. 20773, effective January 21, 2021. 59 O.S. 509.1(E), *et seq*.
- 3. The surrender of my license is freely and voluntarily made. I have not been subject to any coercion or duress, and I am fully aware of the consequences of the surrender of my license.
- 4. I admit that I am the subject of a proceeding by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision ("Board") involving allegations which, if proven, would constitute grounds for disciplinary action by the Board.
- 5. On November 20, 2018, in State of Oklahoma v. Bryan Perry, District Court of Oklahoma County (Case No. CF-2018-5257), I was charged with Manslaughter in the Second Degree, a felony as well as the following misdemeanors: aggravated driving under the influence, leaving the scene of an accident resulting in death and obstructing an officer in the performance of their official duties.

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- 6. On January 11, 2019, I obtained a substance abuse assessment at Bradford Health Services and subsequently received in-patient treatment.
- 7. On March 2, 2020, a jury found me guilty of Manslaughter in the Second Degree, a felony, as well as the three misdemeanors.
- 8. On May 21, 2020, I was sentenced to 15 years and a fine of \$10,000 on the Manslaughter in the Second degree felony conviction.
- 9. I am guilty of unprofessional conduct by violating the following rules of professional conduct:
 - a. Conviction of any felony in or without the State of Oklahoma and whether in a state or federal court. 59 O.S. § 513(A)(2)(3).
 - b. Conviction of a crime involving a determination by a judge or jury. 59 O.S. § 509(7)(d).
 - c. The conviction of a felony, whether or not related to the practice of medicine and surgery. Okla. Admin. Code § 435:10-7-4(10).
- 10. I hereby submit my wallet card and wall certificate as evidence of my intent to surrender my license. 59 O.S. § 509(E)(2).
- 11. If my felony conviction is not overturned on appeal, I agree that, should the Board ever vote to restore my license upon my application, I must undergo a full multidisciplinary evaluation by a facility preapproved by the Board Secretary, to determine my readiness to return to the practice of medicine. I further agree that if my license is restored it will be under terms of probation as determined at that time.
- 12. If the felony conviction is overturned on appeal and no other appeals are sought, the Board shall restore the license of the physician. 59 O.S. 513(A)(3). I agree that, prior to my license being restored, I must undergo a full multidisciplinary evaluation by a facility preapproved by the Board Secretary, to determine my readiness to return to the practice of medicine. I further agree that if my license is restored it will be under terms of probation as determined at that time.
- 13. If the Board does not accept this Voluntary Surrender In Lieu of Prosecution the Plaintiff and Defendant (collectively, the "Parties") stipulate that it shall be regarded as null and void. Admissions by Defendant herein, if any, shall not be regarded as evidence against him in a subsequent disciplinary hearing. Defendant will be free to defend himself, and no inferences will be made from his willingness to have this Order accepted by the Board. The Parties stipulate that neither the presentation of the Order nor the Board's consideration of this Order shall be deemed to have unfairly or illegally prejudiced the Board or its individual members and, therefore, shall not be grounds for precluding the Board nor any

14. As a condition to accepting my voluntary surrender of license in lieu of prosecution, I acknowledge that the Board shall require me to pay all costs expended by the Board for any legal fees and cost, any investigation, probation and monitoring fees, including but not limited to staff time, salary and travel expense, witness fees and attorney fees.
