ORDER DENYING REINSTATEMENT OF MEDICAL LICENSE

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on May 3, 2001, at the Board office, 5104 North Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73118, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Faith Ann Coleman, Applicant, appeared in person.

Elizabeth A. Scott, Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.

The Board *en banc* heard testimony, reviewed the exhibits presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, entered the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1 Applicant previously held Oklahoma Medical License No. 20966.
- 2. On May 9, 2000, the Board entered an Order accepting Applicant's Voluntary Surrender of License in Lieu of Prosecution for unprofessional conduct in violation of 59 O.S. §509 (5), (9) and (16), and OAC 435:10-7-4 (3), (11), (18), (39) and (40).
 - 3. Applicant has applied for reinstatement of her license.
- 4. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein pursuant to 59 O.S. §480 et seq.
- 2. The Applicant has failed to sustain her burden of proof that she has met all requirements for reinstatement of her medical license at this time.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1 Applicant's request for reinstatement of her medical license shall be **DENIED**.
- 2. A copy of this written order shall be sent to Applicant as soon as it is processed.
