ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF SPECIAL TRAINING LICENSE

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on June 29, 2007, at the Board office, 5104 North Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73118, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Defendant, Billy Conn Beets, M.D., appeared in person and pro se.

Elizabeth A. Scott, Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.

The Board *en banc* heard testimony, reviewed the exhibits presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, entered the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Orders:

Findings of Fact

1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

2. On November 3, 2006, after hearing before the Board en banc, the Board entered a Final Order of Suspension whereby it suspended Defendant's license indefinitely with certain conditions to be met prior to seeking reinstatement.

3. Defendant is now seeking reinstatement of his Oklahoma medical license no. 21208.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to reinstate the license of a physician pursuant to 59 O.S. §508.1.

2. The Board may impose practice parameters and other restrictions as necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public under 59 O.S. §480 *et seq.*

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. Defendant's medical license shall be reinstated as a SPECIAL TRAINING LICENSE.

2. Defendant's special training medical license shall be **RESTRICTED** to the University of Oklahoma Family Practice Residency Program with no external moonlighting allowed.

3. If the Board ever modifies the restriction on Defendant's Oklahoma special training medical license or grants him a full medical license, it may be under terms of probation to be determined at the time of modification or subject to further restrictions.

4. Promptly upon receipt of an invoice for such charges, Defendant shall pay all costs of this action authorized by law, including without limitation, legal fees and investigation costs.

5. Failure to meet any of the terms of restriction will constitute cause for the Board to initiate additional proceedings to suspend or revoke Defendant's license, after due notice and hearing.

6. A copy of this written order shall be sent to Defendant as soon as it is processed.
