FINAL ORDER

)

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners en banc on September 28, 1985, at 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Daniel J. Gamino, Attorney, appeared for the Plaintiff and the Defendant did not appear either in person by representative.

The Board of Medical Examiners en banc heard the testimony, reviewed exhibits and being fully advised in the premises, the Board of Medical Examiners therefore finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That Wayne G. Hill, holds Certificate of Limited Institutional Practice No. L-405.

2. That the Board of Medical Examiners en banc has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein and that notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

3. That the Board obtained personal jurisdiction over Defendant by publication of Notice in an Oklahoma County daily newspaper on the dates of July 30, August 6, and August 13, 1985, and by publication of the Notice in a daily newspaper in Woodward County on the dates of July 30, August 7 and August 14, 1985.

4. That on or around March 21, 1985, the Oklahoma Board of Medical Examiners received from Dr. Juan A. Silva S., Dean of Medicine, Universidad Central del Este, Dominican Republic, information that the diploma submitted to the Board by the aforesaid Wayne G. Hill was false and had in fact been issued to another student, Maria Del Pilar Serrano Pernas, and that the aforesaid Wayne G. Hill was admitted to the aforesaid institution in September, 1976, but did not complete even one semester, and immediately withdrew.

5. That the diploma submitted by the Defendant, Wayne G. Hill, was relied on by the Board in issuing the Defendant a certificate authorizing him to do limited institutional practice. 1. That Wayne G. Hill, holding Certificate of Limited Institutional Practice No. L-405, is in violation of the Oklahoma Medical Practice Act, 59 O.S. 1981, §508, to-wit:

> "Whenever any license or certificate has been procured or obtained by fraud or misrepresentation, or was issued by mistake; or if the diploma of graduation in medicine and surgery or any other credentials required as necessary to the ... certificate, were obtained by fraud or misrepresentation or issued by mistake ... it shall be the duty of the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of Oklahoma to revoke such license or certificate in the same manner as is provided for in this Act for the revocation of license or certificate for unprofessional conduct."

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Examiners of Oklahoma as follows:

1. That Limited Institutional Practice Certificate No. L-405 issued to Wayne G. Hill should be and the same is hereby revoked.
