B. From November 1-3, 1999, Defendant voluntarily and without approval failed to participate in his assigned rotation with the intensive care team at St. John's Medical Center in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Defendant subsequently resigned from all duties, responsibilities and obligations within the Department of Family Practice effective November 30, 1999.

C. Defendant is guilty of unprofessional conduct in that he:


Engaged in practice or other behavior that demonstrates an incapacity or incompetence to practice medicine and surgery pursuant to 435:10-7-4(18).

Violated any provision of the medical practice act or the rules and regulations of the Board or of an action, stipulation, or agreement of the Board pursuant to 435:10-7-4(39).

5. I hereby submit my wallet card and wall certificate as evidence of my intent to surrender my license.

6. As a condition to accepting my surrender of license in lieu of prosecution, I acknowledge that the Board may require me to pay all costs expended by the Board for any legal fees and costs, and any investigation, probation and monitoring fees, including but not limited to staff time, salary and travel expense, witness fees and attorney fees.
