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ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Medical Board of Licensure and Supervision on January 10, 2013, at the office of the Board, 101 N.E. 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Defendant, Michael Lynn Partin, M.D., appeared in person and with his attorney, John W. Coyle, III.

Scott Randall Sullivan, Special Prosecutor, appeared on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. The Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.

The Board *en banc* heard testimony, reviewed the Motion and being fully apprised of the premises, entered the following Findings of Fact, conclusions of Law, and Orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and rules of the Board.
- 2. On July 12, 2012, after hearing before the Board *en banc*, the Board entered a Order Accepting Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction based upon allegations of misconduct contained in the complaint filed February 3, 2012.
- 3. Dr. Partin is seeking to terminate the probation entered on July 12, 2012.

4. After hearing testimony and examining evidence, the Board has determined that there is no evidence of Alcohol Abuse or Domestic Abuse by Dr. Partin, and that it is appropriate to terminate his probation, and that he have a full, unrestricted medical license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction to reinstate the license of a physician pursuant to 59 O.S. §508.1
- 2. The Board may impose practice parameters and other restrictions as necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public under 59 O.S. §480 et seq. The Board may also modify, or remove entirely, previously placed restrictions.

<u>ORDER</u>

It is therefore **ORDERED** by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. Dr. Partin's probation, the terms of which are described in the order Accepting Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction dated July 12, 2012, is hereby terminated. Dr. Partin shall now have a full, unrestricted medical license.
