ORDER OF CONTINUANCE

The undersigned Secretary for the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision (“Board”), in consideration of the Application for Continuance of Hearing received from Defendant, enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. A Verified Complaint for Professional Misconduct and Citation were each filed July 7, 2017 (“Complaint”). Hearing was set for the January 11, 2018 Board meeting.
2. Defense counsel Jack Freese, Sr. was served with the Complaint and other administrative documents on July 12, 2017. A Proof of Service was filed August 2, 2017.
3. Plaintiff was notified on January 2, 2018 that Defense Counsel Jack Freese, Sr. has unexpectedly had surgery.
4. An Entry of Appearance as counsel for Defendant, of Lance Freije and Leigh Anne Carson of Latham Wagner Steele Lehman, P.C., was received and filed on January 3, 2018.
5. Defendant’s Application for Continuance of Hearing, advising Mr. Freese will be withdrawing as attorney of record, was filed January 3, 2018.
6. For good cause shown the Application for Continuance of Hearing of Defendant is hereby granted, and the Complaint will be heard at the meeting of the Board on March 8, 2018, which will begin at 9:00 a.m.
7. All deadlines are reset pursuant to the Scheduling Order – March 2018, filed August 17, 2017, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.





SCHEDULING ORDER – MARCH 2018

This Scheduling Order is issued pursuant to Okla. Admin. Code § 435:3-3-7. Alteration of this Scheduling Order shall only be approved upon written motion for good cause shown, to the Board Secretary or Trial Examiner.

1.	File dispositive motions	February 1, 2018
2.	Exchange final witness and exhibit lists	February 1, 2018
3.	Discovery completed/answered	February 15, 2018
4.	Pre-trial conference (as needed, to review contested items)	<u>earlier or by:</u> February 22, 2018
5.	Enter into VSJ or SILOP	February 22, 2018
6.	File written continuance motion	March 1, 2018
7.	Board Hearing	March 8, 2018

- **Answer** – The defendant shall file a written answer under oath, to the complaint, within 20 days after service of the citation. If the answer is not filed, the defendant shall be considered in default. 12 Okla. Stat. § 2012 and Okla. Admin. Code § 435:3-3-8 *et seq.* Failure to file an answer may subject defendant to *default judgment*.
- **Discovery** - The failure of a party to have sufficient time to exercise any discovery mechanism on account of a lack of time shall not of itself constitute good cause for the granting of a continuance. Okla. Admin. Code § 435:3-3-9.
- **THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 22, 2018** is the deadline to enter into a voluntary agreement. Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction (“VSJ”), or Surrender in Lieu of Prosecution (“SILOP”), Okla. Admin. Code § 435:5-1-5.1; Okla. Stat. § 509.1(E). If a VSJ or SILOP has not been executed and submitted to the Board by the deadline, the case will proceed to hearing on **MARCH 8, 2018**.
- **Continuance** - Okla. Admin. Code § 435:3-3-7(c).
