ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE

This matter came before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision (“Board”) on May 14, 2015, at the Board office, 101 N.E. 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Defendant, Jeffrey Porras, M.D., appeared in person and with counsel Linda Scoggins and Kaylee Davis-Maddy.

Joseph L. Ashbaker, Assistant Attorney General, and Jason T. Seay, Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, *ex rel.* the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.

The Board *en banc* after hearing arguments of counsel, reviewing the exhibits admitted and the sworn testimony of witnesses, and being fully advised in the premises found that there was clear and convincing evidence to support the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

Findings of Fact

1. Defendant, Jeffrey Porras, M.D., holds Oklahoma medical license no. MD 23554. The acts and omissions complained of were made while Defendant was acting as a physician pursuant to his medical license conferred upon him by the State of Oklahoma.

2. On August 22, 2014, the State issued a Citation and Complaint against the Defendant making allegations against the Defendant and seeking permanent revocation of Jeffrey Porras’ medical license.

3. After review of the pleadings submitted and hearing the evidence presented, the Board found that the State had failed to prove by clear and convincing evidence the allegations

set forth in the Complaint and, therefore, the Board dismissed the Complaint against the Defendant.

Conclusions of Law

1. The Board is a duly authorized agency of the State of Oklahoma empowered to license and oversee the activities of physicians and surgeons in the State of Oklahoma pursuant to 59 O.S. § 480, *et seq.*

2. The Board therefore has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein pursuant to 59 O.S. § 480 *et seq.*


3. The State failed to prove by clear and convincing evidence the allegations set forth in the Complaint.

4. The Board's Complaint against Jeffrey Porras, M.D. is to be hereby dismissed.
