ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on March 13, 2008, at the Board office, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Applicant, Adam Leroy, M.D., holding Oklahoma medical license no. 24160 appeared in person and pro se.

The Board sitting *en banc* after hearing testimony, reviewing the request and other materials presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, made the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

*FINDINGS OF FACT*

1. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.
2. Dr. Leroy currently holds medical license no. 24160 under a five (5) year term of probation that commenced on or around May 11, 2006.
3. Dr. Leroy has requested that his probation be terminated effective March 13, 2008 so as to allow him sit for his Family Practice Board Examination.
4. Tom Sosbee, Compliance and Education Coordinator for the Board, testified that Dr. Leroy had complied to date with the terms of probation and that Dr. Leroy's counselors no longer recommended that Dr. Leroy be drug tested. Mr. Sosbee further testified that the Board staff did not object to the requested termination.

5. Dr. Leroy has complied to date in all respects with the terms of probation, and the purposes of the probationary period have been accomplished. Dr. Leroy has presented sufficient evidence to support the requested early termination.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to 59 O. S. § 480 *et seq.*

2. Dr. Leroy has presented satisfactory evidence to justify termination of the remainder of his probationary period. The purposes of the probationary period have been accomplished by Dr. Leroy's compliance with the probationary terms. No useful purpose would be gained by having Dr. Leroy serve the remainder of his probationary term.


**ORDER**

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. Dr. Leroy's application to terminate probation is **GRANTED** and his probationary period is terminated effective March 13, 2008.


2. A copy of this written order should be sent to Dr. Leroy as soon as it is processed.
