ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF MEDICAL LICENSE

The undersigned Secretary of the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision (“Board”), in consideration of the agreement of Plaintiff, Defendant and respective counsel (herein, the “Parties”), enters the following order:

1. On December 12, 2019, a Verified Complaint (“2019 Complaint”) and Citation were each filed. Hearing was set for March 5, 2020. Defendant was served by Larry Rhodes, Director of Investigations for the Board, on December 12, 2019 and a Return of Service was filed on December 12, 2019.
2. An Answer to the 2019 Complaint was filed on February 10, 2020, by Rachel N. Jordan of Mulinix, Goerke & Meyer, PLLC, as counsel for Defendant.
3. On April 10, 2020, a Second Agreed Order of Continuance with Notice of Hearing (“Second Continuance Order”) was filed.
4. The Second Continuance Order provided:

The Parties have conferred and hereby request a continuance of the 2019 Complaint to the June 25, 2020 Board meeting, and the continuance shall be subject to the following specific conditions:

- a. Defendant shall be subject to random drug and alcohol testing, including urine and PEth tests, which will be under the supervision of the Board Compliance Coordinator.

- b. In the event that a positive result was received by the Board for either the urine or PEth tests and upon receipt of a positive confirmatory test, Defendant agrees that his license will be automatically suspended pending the Board hearing scheduled for the 2019 Complaint.
5. On April 14, 2020, Dr. Wilson submitted for random drug and alcohol testing. ("April 14, 2020 Test"). The test was a split sample test.
 6. On April 16, 2020, the Board received the April 14, 2020 Test results, which indicated a positive test result for a controlled dangerous substance.
 7. On April 16, 2020, a request was made to have the split sample tested. ("Split Sample Test")
 8. On April 28, 2020, the Board received the Split Sample Test results, which indicated a positive test result for a controlled dangerous substance.
 9. Pursuant to the agreement of the parties as set forth in the Second Continuance Order, the medical license of Dr. Mark Stephen Wilson, M.D. #24648 is automatically suspended pending the Board hearing scheduled for the 2019 Complaint.
