ORDER OF CONTINUANCE

The undersigned Secretary for the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, in consideration of the parties' joint request for a continuance, enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

- Defendant's hearing on the Complaint was initially set for May 16, 2013 and was subsequently continued to July 25, 2013 and September 11, 2013 in order for Defendant to complete a skills and competency evaluation at KSTAR.
- Defendant completed the above-mentioned skills and competency evaluation and the report was made available to all counsel.
- In March of 2014, Defendant respectfully requested a continuance until the May 2014 board meeting to allow her time to apply to medical education programs in order to reestablish her professional competency.
- In May of 2014, Defendant requested a continuance until June of 2014 to allow her more time to apply to medical education programs in order to reestablish her professional competency.
- 5. In June of 2014, Defendant requested a continuance to the July 17, 2014 Board Agenda to allow her more time to work out the details with the Board staff

regarding whether or not to proceed with the medical education program in order to reestablish her professional competency.

- 6. In July of 2014, the parties requested a joint continuance due to their ongoing settlement communications and the potential need for Defendant to obtain further assessments prior to the hearing of this matter.
- 7. In September of 2014, the parties requested a joint continuance in order for Defendant to obtain a psychiatric assessment by a physician approved of by the Board to conduct such psychiatric assessments. As of this date, Defendant has been unable to schedule such assessment due to scheduling demands of the Board approved physician.
- Currently, the parties request a joint continuance in order for Defendant to obtain a psychiatric assessment by a physician approved of by the Board to conduct such psychiatric assessments.
- 9. Defendant has an Agreement not to Practice with the Board.
- 10. For good cause shown, the parties' joint request for a continuance is hereby granted and Defendant will make an appearance before the Board at its meeting scheduled for January 15, 2015.
