ORDER OF CONTINUANCE

The undersigned Secretary for the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, in consideration of the parties' joint request for a continuance, enters the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

1. Defendant's hearing on the Complaint and Citation pending in this case was originally set for July 12, 2012. There have been five prior continuances and this matter was most recently continued until the September 12, 2013 Board agenda.
2. The parties request a continuance in light of new evidence just made available to Board Staff and this case being of a complex nature. This new evidence consists of the deaths of three (3) of Defendant's patients and was only very recently discovered by Board Staff. This new evidence of three (3) patient deaths will be the subject of a Second Amended Complaint against Defendant to be filed no later than Friday, August 30, 2013.
3. The parties respectfully request herein that this matter be rescheduled for

November 7, 2013.

4. For good cause shown, the parties' joint request for a continuance is hereby granted and Defendant's hearing is rescheduled before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision en banc at its regularly scheduled meeting on November 7, 2013.
