ORDER DENYING REINSTATEMENT
OF MEDICAL LICENSE
AFTER SURRENDER IN LIEU OF PROSECUTION

This matter came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision on January 15, 2015, at the Board office, 101 N.E. 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105, pursuant to notice given as required by law and rules of the Board.

Michael Edward Hume, P.A., Applicant, appeared in person and pro se.

Jason T. Seay, Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, *ex rel.* the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision.

The Board *en banc* heard testimony, reviewed the exhibits presented, and being fully apprised of the premises, entered the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Orders:

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant previously held Oklahoma physician assistant license no. 281.
2. On September 6, 2013 at 2:05 p.m. Board Secretary emergently suspended Applicant's license pending a full hearing before the Board *en banc* at the next meeting scheduled for November 7, 2013.

3. On November 7, 2013, the Board accepted Applicant's voluntary surrender of his Oklahoma physician assistant license in lieu of prosecution.
4. On September 16, 2014, Applicant applied for reinstatement of his Oklahoma physician assistant license no. 281.
5. The Board *en banc* has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein, and notice has been given in all respects as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Conclusions of Law


1. The Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter herein pursuant to 59 O.S. § 480 *et seq.*
2. The Applicant has failed to sustain his burden of proof that he has met all requirements for reinstatement of his medical license, including the requirement that he be of good moral character and competent to practice safely as required by 59 O.S. § 495h.

Order

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

1. Applicant's request for reinstatement of his Oklahoma physician assistant license is **DENIED**.
2. Promptly upon receipt of an invoice, Defendant shall pay all costs of this action authorized by law, including without limitation, legal fees and costs, investigation costs, staff time, salary and travel expenses, witness fees and attorney's fees
3. A copy of this written order shall be sent to Applicant as soon as it is processed.
