COMES NOW the plaintiff, the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, and for its Dismissal Without Prejudice, submits the following:


1. On or about June 30, 2011, the State filed a Complaint and Citation against Defendant based upon her alleged failure to obtain and timely submit proof of compliance with continuing medical education requirements.

2. Subsequent to the filing of the Complaint and Citation, Defendant supplied documentation that she had timely obtained the required continuing medical education and that she had no knowledge that the Board had requested proof of her compliance.

3. Based upon a review of the new evidence submitted by Defendant, the State has elected to dismiss without prejudice its complaint against Defendant.

WHEREFORE, the State of Oklahoma hereby dismisses its complaint against Defendant, Angela June Avery, OTA, License No. OA316, without prejudice to the refile of the same.


