#### FINAL ORDER OF REVOCATION

This cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision (the "Board") on March 7, 2013, at the office of the Board, 101 N.E. 51<sup>st</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, pursuant to notice given as required by law and the rules of the Board.

Scott Randall Sullivan, Special Prosecutor for the Board, appeared for the plaintiff and Defendant appeared not.

The Board *en banc*, being fully advised in the premises, found that there is clear and convincing evidence to support the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

## **Findings of Fact**

- 1. The Board is a duly authorized agency of the State of Oklahoma empowered to license and oversee the activities of physicians and surgeons in the State of Oklahoma pursuant to 59 Okla. Stat. §480 et seq. The Board has jurisdiction over this matter, and notice has been given in all respects in accordance with law and the rules of the Board.
- 2. Defendant, Jason Allen Briggs, R.C., holds respiratory care license no. RC3171 and has practiced in Oklahoma.
- 3. Defendant received proper notice of this hearing via certified mail on January 22, 2013 at 11:13 a.m.

### Conclusions of Law

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction and authority over the Defendant and subject matter herein pursuant to the Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure and Supervision Act (the "Act") and its applicable regulations. The Board is authorized to enforce the Act as necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare.
  - 2. Pursuant to OCA Rule 435:3-3-14:

Any defendant who fails to appear as directed, after first having received proper notice, shall be deemed by the Board to have waived his or her right to present a defense to the charges alleged in the complaint, and the Board may deem the allegation of the complaint and citation to be true and correct as alleged. Thereupon, the Board may vote to take disciplinary action upon the allegations of the complaint and citation, as appropriate for the nature of the allegations.

3. The Board further found that the Defendant's license should be **REVOKED** based upon OAC Title 435:3-3-14 as stated above.

#### Order

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision as follows:

- 1. The license of Defendant, Jason Allen Briggs, R.C., respiratory care license no. RC3171, is hereby **REVOKED** as of the date of this hearing, March 7, 2013.
- 2. Promptly upon receipt of an invoice, Defendant shall pay all costs of this action authorized by law, including without limitation, legal fees and costs, investigation costs, staff time, salary and travel expenses, witness fees and attorney's fees.
