
DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE

COMES NOW the plaintiff, the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, and for its Dismissal Without Prejudice, submits the following:

1. On or about October 18, 2001, the State filed a Complaint and Citation against Defendant based upon her submission of a false visit slip.
2. Subsequent to the filing of the Complaint and Citation, Defendant supplied testimony that her visit slip was not false but was an unintentional mistake.
3. Based upon a review of the new testimony submitted by Defendant and her agreement to have a Letter of Concern from the Board Secretary placed in her public file at the Board offices, the State has elected to dismiss its complaint against Defendant, with Defendant to pay all costs of the investigation and prosecution of this case.

WHEREFOR, the State of Oklahoma hereby dismisses its complaint against Defendant, Andrea Christine Byers, License No. OA325, without prejudice to the refile of the same.


