VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE IN LIEU OF PROSECUTION

I, Michael Reed Simmons, M.D. ("Defendant"), being of lawful age and after first being duly sworn, depose and state as follows:

1. I hereby voluntarily surrender my Oklahoma medical license no. 33164, effective January 16, 2020.
2. The surrender of my license is freely and voluntarily made. I have not been subject to any coercion or duress, and I am fully aware of the consequences of the surrender of my license.
3. I am the subject of a proceeding by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision ("Board") involving allegations which, if proven, would constitute grounds for disciplinary action by the Board.
4. I admit that I was the subject of a proceeding before the Board of the Healing Arts in the State of Kansas styled *In the Matter of Michael Reed Simmons, M.D. Kansas License No, 04-24193*, Docket No. 19-HA-00024 ("Kansas Proceeding").
5. May 1, 2019, I voluntarily surrendered my Kansas medical license resulting in the Final Order of Revocation by Surrender entered in the Kansas Proceeding.

6. On June 7, 2019, The Final Order of Revocation by Surrender was entered in the Kansas Proceeding which provided as follows:

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Licensee's license, Kansas License No. 04-24196 (sic), is REVOKED pursuant to licensee's surrender.

7. On July 18, 2019, a Nunc Pro Tunc was entered in the Kansas Proceeding which provided as follows:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Final Order issued on June 7, 2019, is hereby amended nunc pro tunc to reflect Licensee's correct license number of 04-24193.

8. I, Michael Reed Simmons, M.D., agree the allegations in the Kansas Proceeding would constitute grounds for disciplinary action by the Board herein and therefore I am guilty of unprofessional conduct by violating the following rules of professional conduct:

- a. Disciplinary action of another state or jurisdiction against a license to practice medicine and surgery based upon acts of conduct by the licensee similar to acts or conduct that would constitute grounds for action as defined in this section OAC 435:10-7-4(31).

9. I hereby submit my wallet card and wall certificate as evidence of my intent to surrender my license. 59 O.S. § 509(E)(2).

10. I hereby agree that I will not reapply for reinstatement of my Oklahoma medical license for a minimum of three (3) years from the date this Voluntary Surrender in Lieu of Prosecution ("SILOP") is accepted by the Board. If the Board ever reinstates my license, I agree it shall be under the following terms:


- a. Defendant shall be placed on five (5) years of PROBATION, and shall abide by all terms and conditions thereof;
- b. Defendant shall complete an eight to twelve (8-12) week intensive residential treatment program, approved of in advance by the Board Secretary. The facility of the treatment shall specialize in addressing inappropriate and/or adisruptive behavior among physicians, including both sexual and non-sexual boundary concerns.
- c. Defendant shall sign a five (5) year contract with Oklahoma Health Professionals Program ("OHPP"), with terms reviewed of in advance by the Board Secretary, and Defendant shall abide by all recommendations;
- d. Defendant shall be assessed by a Board approved provider, approved of in advance by the Board Secretary, to evaluate competency and clinical skills prior to re-entry into practice.

11. If the Board does not accept this Voluntary Surrender In Lieu of Prosecution the Plaintiff and Defendant (collectively, the "Parties") stipulate that it shall be regarded as null and void. Admissions by Defendant herein, if any, shall not be regarded as evidence against him in a subsequent disciplinary hearing. Defendant will be free to defend himself, and no inferences will be made from his willingness to have this Order accepted by the Board. The Parties stipulate that neither the presentation of the Order nor the Board's consideration of this Order shall be deemed to have unfairly or illegally prejudiced the Board or its individual members and, therefore, shall not be grounds for precluding the Board nor any individual Board member from further participation in proceedings related to the matters set forth herein.
12. As a condition to accepting my voluntary surrender of license in lieu of prosecution, I acknowledge that the Board shall require me to pay all costs expended by the Board for any legal fees and cost, any investigation, probation and monitoring fees, including but not limited to staff time, salary and travel expense, witness fees and attorney fees.


