VERIFIED COMPLAINT

The State of Oklahoma, ex rel. Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision ("Board"), for its Verified Complaint against Miguel Rodriguez Antonatos, M.D. ("Defendant"), alleges and states as follows:

I. JURISDICTION

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction over the subject matter and is a duly authorized agency of the State of Oklahoma empowered to license and oversee the activities of physicians and surgeons in the State of Oklahoma. 59 O.S. § 480, et seq. and Okla. Admin. Code 435:5-1-1, et seq.
- In Oklahoma, Defendant holds medical license No. 37913, issued 2/26/2021 pursuant to the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact ("IMLC"), 59 O.S. § 493.7, with Illinois as his state of principal license.
- The acts and omissions complained of herein were made while Defendant was licensed to practice medicine by the State of Oklahoma.

II. ALLEGATIONS OF UNPROFESSIONAL CONDUCT

- Defendant is a physician who resides in Illinois and all times material hereto owned and
 operated a telemedicine practice based in Illinois providing consultations to patients in
 multiple states, including in the state of Oklahoma.
- On February 9, 2023, the Washington Medical Commission ("Commission"), which regulates licensed health care professionals, issued a Statement of Charges against Defendant alleging violations of the Revised Code of Washington. The basis of the Commission's action pertained to various standard of care violations in relation to four

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- specific patients, including failure to establish a physician-patient relationship, prescribing medication without proper patient evaluation, and failure to provide adequate informed consent, including discussion of alternative treatments.
- 6. Defendant subsequently entered an Agreed Order before the Commission on or about August 10, 2023, in which he admitted to committing unprofessional conduct in violation of the Revised Code of Washington, and further agreed to be subject to various terms and conditions for a period of five (5) years to maintain his licensure in the state of Washington.
- 7. On September 5, 2023, Defendant self-reported to the Board that he had been subject to an "Enforcement Action" in Washington and further provided the Statement of Charges and Agreed Order for the Board's consideration.

III. VIOLATIONS

- 8. Based on the foregoing, Defendant is guilty of unprofessional conduct as follows:
 - Disciplinary action of another state or jurisdiction against a license or other a. authorization to practice medicine and surgery based upon acts of conduct by the licensee similar to acts or conduct that would constitute grounds for action as defined in this section, a certified copy of the record of the action taken by the other state or jurisdiction being conclusive evidence thereof, in violation of Okla. Admin. Code § 435:10-7-4(31).
 - b. Violation of any provision(s) of the medical practice act or the rules and regulations of the Board or of any action, stipulation, or agreement of the Board in violation of Okla. Admin. Code § 435:10-7-4(39).
 - Further, under Section 10 of the IMLC any disciplinary action taken by a member C. board against a physician licensed through the IMLC shall be deemed unprofessional conduct which may be subject to discipline by other member boards. 59 O.S. § 493.7(10)(a).

V. CONCLUSION

Given the foregoing, the undersigned respectfully requests the Board conduct a hearing, and, upon proof of the allegations contained herein, impose such disciplinary action as authorized by law, up to and including suspension or revocation and any other appropriate action with respect to Defendant's professional license, including an assessment of costs and attorney's fees incurred in this action as provided by law.
