VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE IN LIEU OF PROSECUTION

I, Jeff L. Treadwell, P.A., being of lawful age and after first being duly sworn, depose and state as follows:

- 1. I hereby voluntarily surrender my Oklahoma physician assistant license no. PA620.
- The surrender of my license is freely and voluntarily made. I have not been subject to any coercion or duress, and I am fully aware of the consequences of the surrender of my license.
- I am the subject of a Complaint before the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision involving allegations that if proven, would constitute grounds for disciplinary action by the Board.
 - 4 The allegations to which I have plead guilty are as follows:

Defendant, Jeff L. Treadwell, P.A., holds Oklahoma license no. PA620.

ii. On or about December 27, 2001, while on duty at Logan County Hospital, Defendant was observed to be impaired by his co-workers. He was subsequently terminated by Logan County Hospital. Defendant admits that prior to his termination, he abused alcohol, Ultram and Phentermine.

- iii. Based on the allegations stated above, Defendant is guilty of unprofessional conduct as follows:
 - A. He has violated a provision of the Medical Practice Act or the rules promulgated by the Board pursuant to OAC 435:15-5-11(a)(7).
 - B. He has engaged in dishonorable or immoral conduct which is likely to deceive, defraud, or harm the public in violation of 59 O.S. §509(9) and OAC 435:10-7-4(11).
 - C. He has violated any provision of the medical practice act or the rules and regulations of the Board or of an action, stipulation, or agreement of the Board in violation of OAC 435:10-7-4(39).
 - D. He habitually uses intoxicating liquors or habit-forming drugs in violation of OAC 435:15-5-11(a)(1), 59 O.S. §509(5) and OAC 435:10-7-4(3).
 - E. He is unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety to patients by reason of age, illness, drunkenness, excessive use of drugs, narcotics, chemicals or any other type of material or as a result of any mental or physical condition in violation of 59 O.S. §509(16) and OAC 435:10-7-4(40).
- 5. I hereby submit my wallet card and wall certificate as evidence of my intent to surrender my license.
- 6. I hereby agree that I will not apply for reinstatement of my Oklahoma physician assistant license for a minimum of one year from the entry of the Order Accepting Voluntary Surrender in Lieu of Prosecution, and that if the Board ever reinstates my Oklahoma physician assistant license, it will be under terms of probation to be set by the Board at the time of reinstatement.
 - As a condition to accepting my surrender of license in lieu of prosecution,

I acknowledge that the Board may require me to pay all costs expended by the Board for any legal fees and costs, and any investigation, probation and monitoring fees, including but not limited to staff time, salary and travel expense, witness fees and attorney fees.
