Dear Doctor Blevins:

The Oklahoma State Board of Medical Examiners in regular session on December 7, 1962, took the following action in your case:

"motion was duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, that he be placed on probation for a period of five (5) years with the provisions that he not register for a narcotic permit, that he comply with the provisions of the Medical Practice Act and the Federal and State Narcotic Laws during the period of probation, that he appear before the Board once a year, unless excused by the Secretary of the Board, and, that he authorize a medical report be made to this Board by the V. A. Hospital; failure to comply with the provisions of the probation to result in the automatic revocation of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Oklahoma."

Please take care of the matter of furnishing a medical report to this Board from the V. A. Hospital as soon as you can. We are returning herewith your annual renewal certificate of registration for the fiscal year ending 1963 and your 1961 AMA membership card.
