Dear Doctor Pyeatte:

The Board, in regular session on June 11, 1969, took the following action:

" ~~\*\*\*~~ motion was duly made, seconded, and carried, that he be placed on probation for a period of five (5) years with the provisions that he surrender his narcotic permit and order forms, that he not register for a narcotic permit, that he comply with the provisions of the Medical Practice Act and the Federal and State Narcotic Laws and other drug laws during the period of probation, and that he appear before the Board at least once a year, starting with the next regular meeting in September, 1969, unless excused by the Secretary of the Board; that he continue to see C. Frank Knox, Jr., M.D. and request Doctor Knox to send the Board regular progress reports prior to each appearance before the Board; failure to comply with the provisions of the probation to result in the automatic revocation of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Oklahoma".
